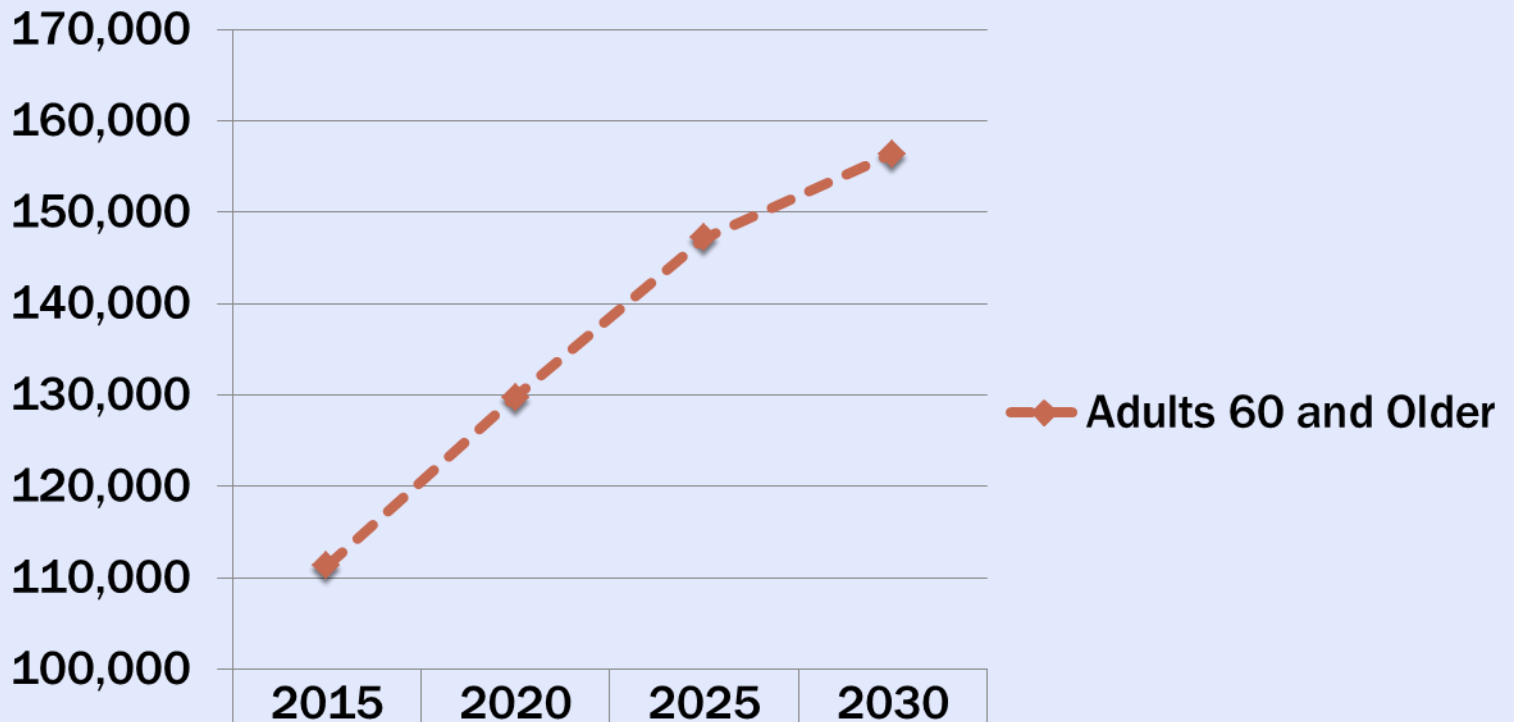

Anne Arundel County, Baltimore City, Baltimore County, Montgomery County and Prince George's County

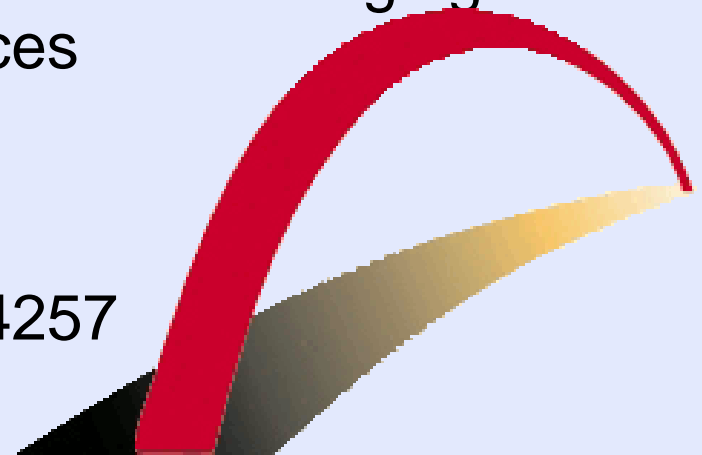

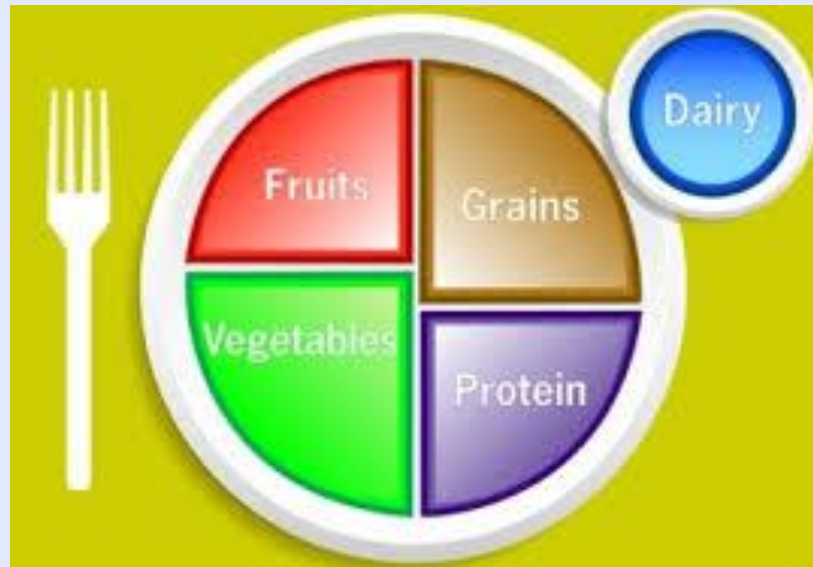

Americans with Disabilities Act Office

- The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Office ensures that every program, service, and activity operated or funded by Anne Arundel County is fully accessible to, and usable by, people with disabilities.
- The ADA Office is responsible for oversight of Anne Arundel County's Title II obligations under the Americans with Disabilities Act

ADA Office

- Investigation and resolution of Title II complaints
- ADA training and technical assistance for County departments/agencies
- Oversight of ADA Compliance within Anne Arundel County Government
- Work with department/agencies' designated ADA Liaisons
- Ensure ADA Accessibility/Compliance in all Capital Projects
- Olmstead (community integration) planning
- Policy and budget recommendations for improving access to people with disabilities
- Commission on Disability Issues
- Resources and advocacy for Anne Arundel County Citizens with disabilities
- Assistance with navigation of barriers in the community faced by people with disabilities
